If you are logging into ConnectCarolina's non-production environment for testing, you will need to claim your Onyen and create a password specifically for the testing environment. If you are logging in from an off-campus location, you must be connected to the Campus VPN.

- 1. Go to <u>ccinfo.unc.edu</u>.
- 2. Click **Training** in the blue menu bar and then click the **For Testers Only** link.
- 3. Click the Claim Your Onyen in SPT tab.

- 12. Finally, you will be asked to set your password. This is the password you will use to log in to the ConnectCarolina SPT environment and it does not impact your production Onyen account or password.
